New Point Of Sale system: Some of our cashiers are still learning to operate our new point of sale system. Please be patient with them as you shop.

Prepacked orders: we love to receive your orders by email, but due to the time involved with packing there will be a **small fee** of \$5 for over 10 items and \$10 for 20 or more. It is also really helpful, especially for larger orders, if you can provide as many of your containers as possible. A great way to do this is to drop a box or basket off on Sundays or early Monday (leave by our door) with your order either as a note in the box or emailed by noon on Mondays.

Special Orders: we are happy to place orders for you with our suppliers, but it is important to **collect them as soon as possible** after they arrive. We don't have space in the co-op to store them and function with shoppers at the same time— particularly full bags of flour etc.
