Remember if you harvest from the garden, please drop a few dollars off in the donation bin if you can afford it, to help us continue to provide beautiful fresh produce for the community.



Member's recipe: Chewy Dried Fruit, Puffed Rice + Nut/Seed Bars

A chewy no bake snack that can be adjusted to suit your favourite flavours or dietary requirements. Makes approximately 14 pieces.

Ingredients

2 ¹/₂ cups puffed rice
¹/₂ cup dried fruit
¹/₄ cup chopped nuts or seeds
¹/₂ cup syrup of choice or ¹/₃ cup runny honey
¹/₂ cup tahini
3 tablespoons coconut oil
1 teaspoon vanilla extract

Step 1

Grease and line a slice tin. Place rice, dried fruit and nuts in a bowl and give it a good mix.

Step 2

Combine syrup/honey, tahini, coconut oil and a pinch of salt in a saucepan, bring to boil. Stir once boiling for 45 seconds, remove from heat and add vanilla and stir.

Step 3

Pour over millet/rice mixture and combine. Transfer to the tin and press down evenly with the back of an oiled spoon to compact.

Step 4

Set aside on a bench until cold and chill in fridge for 1-2 hours until set. Slice into pieces and store in fridge for up to a week.

Items stolen included coins. a wallet. credit cards. sunglasses, an iPad, and power tools. Stealing from a motor vehicle is a crime of opportunity. Offenders look for an easy target. Basic security precautions can reduce the opportunity for theft. Simply ensuring your vehicle is locked, and valuables removed, can be enough for a thief to move on to an easy target. 




